2025 COMMON LAND TREE ASSESSMENT & MANAGEMENT PLAN

The next EHSA Tree Assessment & Management Plan to identify high- and medium-risk trees that should be cut for safety and urban forest management is scheduled to be completed this spring. It will be conducted again by Forester David Hawkins, who is familiar with our common land areas.

BRUSH AND LIMB CLEANUP (HOUSES)

This will be our last year to pick up brush and small limbs from the verges, islands, eyebrows, and other forested areas. The pick-up will be done by May 15. Our tradition has been to clean up small woody debris, such as small limbs from common-owned and town-owned land here, but current best practice for forested urban areas is to let it decompose naturally so that nourishes the forest floor, provides valuable habitat for wildlife by creating snags, and supports the ecosystem through nutrient cycling.

Access to the Common Land Fields

Residents might not realize that a set of steps off Stony Hill Road near the intersection with Gatehouse Road will bring them to a woodsy path and our delightful recreational fields, perfect for relaxing, exercising, gathering, making music, and playing. We recently installed a picnic table with benches at the far end, and hope to add another one soon. The common land paths and fields are open to all EHSA residents and their guests.
